



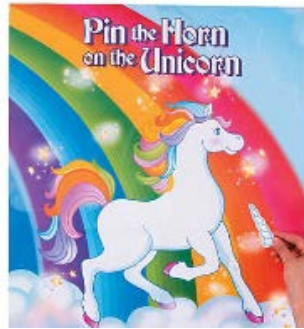
Kindergarten
