Week 5

Everyone is welcome back in week 5. We look forward to seeing you. Some parents may wish to continue to keep their children at home next week. You will find that there will not be an extensive home-based learning program offered. As teachers commence face to face teaching, they will mostly be referring children to Mathletics and Reading Eggs for home-based learning.

Please be aware that drop off and pick up from the school will not be speedy in week 5. Pick up and drop off is only available from Bobbin Head Road. If you have the opportunity could you please practice part of the



drive though process with your children - opening and closing car doors, putting seat belts on – that would be helpful. We appreciate your patience.

You may have noticed that this week in Week 4 we are doing practice drills with the children to get them familiar with how afternoon pick up will take place when all students return to school in Week 5. We have been bringing the children down from class early to practice lining up in allocated lines etc. Pick up still commences 3.00pm.



Keeping our SHP community safe is a priority for us. We have a school hygienist working each day cleaning toilets, desks and other 'high touch' surfaces such as railings and door handles. We use sanitiser and wash hands regularly throughout the day. Teachers model social distancing and remind children about it every

day. We do not allow parents to enter the school grounds – there are no assemblies. If children cough or sniffle, we ask parents to take children home immediately. Please help us to keep Sacred Heart safe.
