No Casual drop-ins will be accepted, staffing arrangements will be made for <u>booked</u> number of children. Due to staff to child ratios, we will not be accepting on the day attendances.



BOOKINGS & GENERAL INFORMATION

Our vacation care service operates between **7:30am – 6:00pm** for children **5** years to 12 years old who are currently enrolled in primary school.

We are licensed to enrol 100 children per day and are required as per Govt. Regulations to maintain the approved staff: child ratio at all times so please book in advance.

Am I eligible to receive Child Care Subsidy (CCS) during Vacation Care?

The Centre is approved for the Child Care Subsidy. You must have a formalised account with the centre to receive your fee reduction.

The new package helps parents with children aged 0 – 13 work, train, study and volunteer. It includes a new Child Care Subsidy, which replaces the current Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate. It will be paid directly to services.

You'll need to complete a Centrelink Child Care Subsidy if you haven't already. You can complete your assessment through <u>myGov</u> using your Centrelink online account or via the Express Plus Centrelink mobile app.

How do I make a booking?

- 1. We will email all enrolled families a LOG ON so you can access BOOK ME
- 2. Then Log onto HUBHELLO select the Love Heart shaped icon on the left hand side of Hubhello page and it will drop down, select BOOK ME

- 4. Book online the days you will need Vacation Care.
- 5. We ask that you email us to advise of your booking oshc.pymble@catholiccaredbb.org.au
- 6. New to Vacation Care: Complete an Enrolment form (must include copies of Immunisation & Birth Certificate) and any Medication Plans, if applicable. Then we will email you a LOGON passwords so you can access BOOK ME
- 7. We will email families to confirm their bookings once we have closed off our bookings on 26th June 2020

If your child has any allergies or dietary restrictions, please discuss with staff prior to attending Vacation Care.

What should my child wear?

Please make sure to clearly label all items of clothing. It is important to ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the weather and the daily activities.

- No singlets or sleeveless tops
- Closed in shoes must be worn (no thongs!)

Children must have a hat to wear each day as per our sun safe policy. **Hats must be worn on excursions.** Please ensure that sunscreen is applied before your child attends vacation care. Educators will ensure that sunscreen is applied throughout the day. We don't need to apply sunscreen between May-July.

If you prefer that your child use a different sunscreen to the one provided by CatholicCare please ensure they have it in their bag and educators will remind them to apply it.

What if my child needs medication?

Prescription medication can only be administered by educators with written permission from the parent/guardian. This is actioned by completed a medication form available at the OSHC service.

Medication must be handed to an educator in its original packaging with the prescribed dosage information and use-by date. Non-prescription medication cannot be administered by educators, as per CatholicCare policy.

- 1. We will require a copy of your child's Current Medical Plan that is signed by your GP (plans created by downloading from internet will not be accepted)
- 2. We will require Medication that is on Child's Medical Plan only
- 3. If your child requires any other medication, it must be prescribed by a GP

STAYING SAFE FROM COVID19

- 1. We will check temperatures of each child upon arrival
- 2. We ask that parents leave unwell children at home
- 3. Staff will check their temperatures at each shift
- 4. Staff to stay at home if unwell
- 5. Hand Sanitiser will be provided
- 6. Hand washing practiced throughout the day
- 7. Dishwasher used
- 8. Bathroom taps, toilet buttons, door handles, hard surfaces are sprayed regularly
- 9. Gloves worn when cooking

If a child becomes unwell during the day, parents will be called to collect their child & your child will be kept monitored for health reasons

& also isolated in a safe environment until parent arrives.


