

## Curriculum Overview Year 2 Term 3 2020

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

**A Community that Celebrates God's Love** - students will explore the Parish as an integral part of God's family. The focus is on the nature of how people celebrate, serve and grow in faith and love together. This module will introduce children to the parish family as a means of celebrating God's love with each other and with people beyond the parish community.

### ENGLISH

Students will be involved in daily literacy learning experiences. We will focus on a range of imaginative and informative texts which we will explore through reading, viewing and writing. We are especially excited to participate in an online Writer's Festival hosted by Little Scribe, enabling students to learn from published authors. Students will have the opportunity to continue practising their Public Speaking skills when they present a learned speech to an audience.

*Home tasks: We will continue to use Wushka for home reading this term and we encourage students to read books to an adult daily.*

**MATHEMATICS** - Students will continue revising concepts of multiplication, division, addition and subtraction. They will explore concepts relating to measurement and geometry such as area, volume and capacity through hands-on activities. The children will be given opportunities to use mathematical ideas and make connections to solve problems using a variety of mental and written strategies.

*Home tasks - Parents will be integral in assisting children to build on skills and confidence in their counting goals.*

### HSIE (Geography) - Features of Places

Students will start a unit exploring the features of places which will continue into Term 4. Students will look at how natural and human caused features create unique environments. We will also explore how and why these places can change.

### SCIENCE and TECHNOLOGY - Scope It

We are very excited to have 'Scope IT' come to Sacred Heart this term and work with each class on developing and enhancing the students' coding and digital technology skills. Each class will have a 40 minute lesson every Monday. Students will work on identifying components of digital systems and will explore how data is represented and transmitted. Students will also participate in activities exploring oceans which is linked to the Science week theme of 'Deep Blue.'

**VISUAL ARTS** - Students will be creating artworks using various mediums linking to our Geography unit on Places and the Science week ocean theme 'Deep Blue.'

**MUSIC** - Creative Arts lessons with Mrs Forster on Wednesdays. Students will focus on a variety of musical concepts. They will also explore elements of drama in a unit based on Where the Wild Things Are.

**PDH - I Can Do It:** Students will identify the qualities and strengths required to develop resilience and determination through exploring a range of stories about individuals and groups who have overcome challenges. They will identify the characteristics they themselves possess and appreciate the assistance they have gained from people around them.














**PE** - Students will attend 45 minute swimming lessons everyday in Weeks 7 and 8, more information to come. With Mr Nosti, students will develop manipulative skills of, pass, catch and dribble through modified Basketball games. Students will also focus on movement skills and balance.

### INTEGRATED LEARNING LIBRARY Library Day is Tuesday All students **will need a Library bag to borrow.**

Students will engage in learning which focuses around non-fiction texts and will explore this section in the Literacy Centre, making observations and comparisons between factual and imaginative texts. Students will complete introductory lessons on the Dewey Decimal System as a global way of organising books. Students will be involved in learning tasks centered around the new 2020 CBCA Picture Books of the year. In Weeks 5 and 9 the Literacy Centre lesson will be STEM focused.
